



## **MEET ADVICE JANUARY**

I have reviewed the competitions in January following discussion with Liz at the weekend. I no longer want the club to do the Maxwell level 2 meet as the majority of swimmers eligible for this meet already have County qualifying times and will be attending Derby & possibly the Zonal. Instead I have replaced it with the Rushmoor level 3 meet on the 14/15 January. The reason for this is that I want a meet which allows swimmers who can't yet qualify for a level 2 meets to get the chance to achieve County qualifying times before the County closing date.

My Advice for which meet to enter in January is:

### **Abingdon Level 3:**

- Swimmers in a All squads except A1 who are trying to get County Qualifying times.
- Those swimmers who already have County Qualifying times in their main events may enter their weaker events to gain Qualifying times.

**N.B. Please note that entries are due in for this meet as it is a first come first served basis meet.**

### **Rushmoor Level 3:**

- Swimmers in All squads (except A1) who are trying to get County Qualifying times.

**N.B. Swimmers selected for the Home Counties Team may be able to enter the first session at Rushmoor on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> but should not enter the last session on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup>.**

### **Derby Level 1:**

All A1 swimmers should enter Derby plus those swimmers in B1 & A2 who already have County Qualification times & who are aiming for Regional & National times.

### **Zonal Meet Level 1:**

Zonal Meets are for Regional level swimmers & above. The Qualifying times are more difficult than Regional times.

**N.B. All swimmers who achieve Qualifying times should enter this meet**

### **Swindon Last Chance Meet (Level 3):**

A2, B2, A3, and C1-4 This meet is ideal for swimmers with a few County times or close to county times.

If you are still unsure which meet to enter please speak with your group Coach or the Head Coach.
